5. Create ongoing sustainable income for the Flathead Food Bank

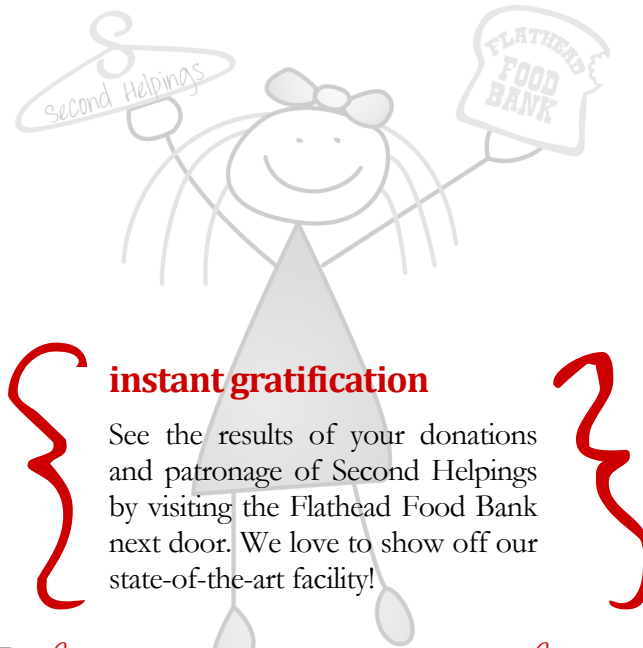
## ♡ what we do
